

Children's Privacy

Teachers/Parents/Guardians,

The Eisenhower Foundation, IKEducation, aims to protect children's privacy. Because most U.S. 6-12th grade students are minors (under the age of 18), permission from a parent/legal guardian is required if they are filmed (by themselves or others). Because of the required permissions, entries to this contest must be made by a student's parent/legal guardian, or by their teacher who has written parental permission, on the student's behalf (unless student is 18).

As a teacher, you must follow your school or district's policies regarding students recording themselves or each other (photo, video and/or audio). In many schools, that means parental consent is not required if the work produced is *only used internally, by the teacher or school*. However, when you submit your students' projects to this national contest, you must also ensure permission is gained for each and every student appearing in an entry to be used by The Eisenhower Foundation in promotional materials, social media, and future contests, etc. **Visit with your school or district administration for guidance on how to collect this permission, or if it is already included within the school's current policy.**

Full student names will not be used in any promotional materials. If you would like to assign an alias name to a student, that option is on the entry form. You, the teacher, will be responsible for keeping a key of what alias goes with which student.
