MEMORANDUM FOR MR. STEPHENS:

Upon the instructions of the President of Mexico, His Excellency Señor Don Manuel Tello, Ambassador of Mexico, has requested an appointment with the President in order to deliver a letter from President Ruiz Cortines in regard to renewing talks regarding a migrant labor agreement. *xo F 20*

The Acting Secretary concurs in the recommendation that the Ambassador's request be granted. It is suggested, however, that the appointment be arranged after February 2 because of our negotiations in Mexico City on this subject.

The Ambassador has requested, if an appointment is arranged, that no publicity be given in regard to his call in order to avoid newspaper speculation concerning the agreement.

A background memorandum is being prepared for the President's information and will be submitted on February 1.

Please let me know whether it will be convenient for the President to receive the Ambassador and, if so, upon what date.
