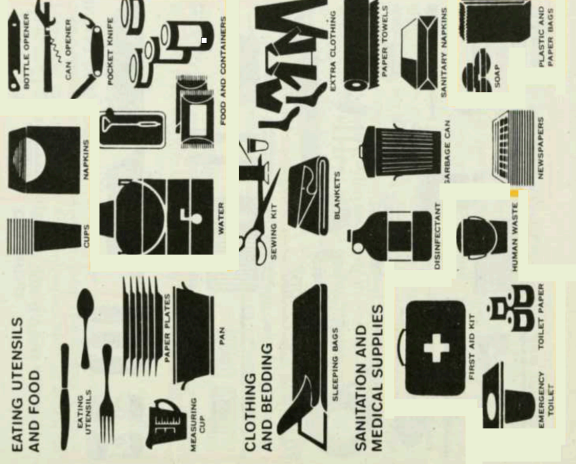

FALLOUT SHELTER
