

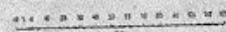
This is a captured German map that depicts where the Nazis believed Allied forces were located in South-east England and how large they estimated those forces were. In reality, most of those troops were non-existent, created by the fictional FUSAG, so this map gave feedback to how well the Allies' deception systems were working.
