DET., ARMY OF THE UNITED STATES, to rank as such from the TENTH day of JUNE one thousand nine hundred and FORTY-TWO. He is therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of TECHNICIAN FOURTH GRADE by doing and performing all manner of things therein to belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all Noncommissioned Officers and Soldiers under his command to be obedient to his orders as TECHNICIAN FOURTH GRADE. And he is to observe and follow such orders and directions from time to time, as he shall receive from his Superior Officers and Noncommissioned Officers set over him, according to the rules and discipline of War.
