Hamlin was able to play in the minor leagues for the New York Yankees farm club in Joplin MO. Then the war started and Hamlin like most men enlisted in the service. He did not qualify to serve because of a childhood sickness so he joined the Coast Guard, thinking he'd stay in the US to defend our home land.
