It was a larger landing craft that was equipped with rockets. Bert started his Pacific tour in Saipan where they prepared for battle in Okinawa. Next they prepared for the invasion of Japan but instead it became the occupation of Japan. When Bert returned from the service he started an alfalfa dehydration industry.
