IKEducation is excited to welcome you to the Eisenhower Presidential Library, Museum, and Boyhood Home. To aid in a smooth arrival and successful trip, here are some helpful tips:

- Our driving address is 400 S. Buckeye Ave, Abilene, KS.
- Upon arrival please drop-off students at the curved corner located in the southeast corner of the Visitor's Center Parking lot. See map.
- **Bus parking** spaces are on the north side of the Visitor's Center parking lot. The south lot is under construction and has limited parking. See map.
- We have asked the lead teacher to please be knowledgeable about the amount of time it takes for a school bus to drive to Abilene, Kansas, and to include extra time for the unexpected bathroom break, road construction, etc. so that the students do not have to miss out on any of their scheduled activities
- If you are running late for any reason, please ask the lead teacher to call us at 785-280-9531.
- If your school has brought sack lunches, please do not leave campus until arrangements have been made to remove lunches from your bus upon arrival.
- If you want to tour the Museum and Boyhood Home, please check in to the Visitors' Center to purchase tickets. Some free activities on campus include: a (25 minute) video overview of Ike's life in the Visitors' Center Auditorium, a (7 minute) video about the Boyhood Home in the Presidential Library Auditorium, the Place of Meditation, and a beautiful campus to walk and enjoy.
- If you are leaving campus on foot for lunch, there is a Casey's across Buckeye Street that offers pizza and subs. Nearby, you will also find an Original Grande.
- If you plan to drive off-campus for lunch, there is a small cluster of fast food options just south of I-70 with bus parking available in the Arby's parking lot. Fast food options in this area include Arby's, Burger King, McDonald's, and Subway.
